Shortly we will begin our Roll Call followed by Club information. You do not need to be a member to participate. We welcome everyone.

We will now have the Roll Call. As usual we first call our board members, followed by our members, regular visitors and any first time visitors. The roll call lists regular check-ins, and is in order by callsign suffix.

We ask all stations operating FM only to stand by during this net and refrain from transmitting as long as there is activity indicated by your S meter or receive light. Your cooperation will be appreciated. I will now stand by until the repeater identifies in FM and then switch to digital mode.

Switch to digital narrow:
